

**ALLIED HEALTH PROFESSIONS ORDINANCE  
(CHAPTER 359)**

**ORDER MADE BY THE PHYSIOTHERAPISTS BOARD**

It is hereby notified that in accordance with the Physiotherapists (Registration and Disciplinary Procedure) Regulation (Cap. 359 sub. leg. J) the Physiotherapists Board, after due inquiry held on 16 September 2025, found [REDACTED] (Registration No. [REDACTED]), being a registered Part Ia physiotherapist, -

- (a) in or about December 2018, sanctioned, acquiesced in or failed to take adequate steps to prevent [REDACTED] from promoting physiotherapy services of [REDACTED] ([REDACTED] clinic) by email;
- (b) sanctioned, acquiesced in or failed to take adequate steps to prevent [REDACTED] from promoting physiotherapy services in its website which did not comply with section 6.2 in Part III of the Code of Practice;

and that in relation to the facts alleged, either individually or cumulatively, she has been guilty of unprofessional conduct.

Pursuant to section 22(1)(iv) of the Allied Health Professions Ordinance (Cap. 359), the Physiotherapists Board ordered on 16 September 2025 that a warning letter be served on [REDACTED] and such order shall not be published in the Government of the Hong Kong Special Administrative Region Gazette.
